

## Camp Regulations

1. Obey all rules!
2. Always show respect and obey the chaperones and leaders of this Retreat.
3. Act with care and respect toward the natural environment, other persons and groups and camp facilities.
4. Camp Lee assumes no responsibility for loss of, or damage to, personal property during your stay.
5. All campers must be in their own rooms and quiet between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:30 a.m.
6. Boys are not allowed to go into girls rooms and girls are not allowed to go into boys rooms. Food and drink are not allowed in rooms.
7. Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, smoking, candles, firearms, hunting implements, ammunition, explosives and fireworks are prohibited.
8. Radios, TV's, electronic games, tape players, CD players and other electronic devices are not allowed.
9. Sports equipments, balls, Frisbees, etc. are not to be used inside the building. Do not tamper with the fire extinguishers.

These rules and guidelines are designed to avoid confusion and to ensure a safe and enjoyable stay at Camp Lee.
